

CONTEST RULES
Win Tickets to See Kevin Lacroix in Action!

1. CONTEST ORGANIZER

The **Win Tickets to See Kevin Lacroix in Action** Contest is held and organized by NAPA CANADA (hereinafter referred to as “the Organizer”).

2. CONTEST PERIOD

The contest will take place in Canada during the [NASCAR Canada Series](#) racing season according to the Series schedule and in the different cities where the races will be held (hereinafter referred to as “the Contest Period”).

3. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

To be eligible for the Contest, a person must:
